

Product carbon footprint through Life Cycle Assessments (LCAs)

We carry out LCAs on our products to understand their impact on the environment so we can act to reduce it.



All estimates of carbon footprint are uncertain. Jabra has followed the LCA reporting rules from ISO 14067:2018 and the relevant Product Category Rules (PCR) from PCRed4-EN-2021 09 06. The report has been verified according to ISO 14067-3 Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of GHG statements, ISO 14065 Requirements for Validation and Verification, & ISO 14066 Competence requirements for GHG validation teams and verification teams. The scope of the LCA covers a 2 years usage period, using a GLO average based on major slaes regions reflecting the average warranty period and average use case.
